## RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

- (1) No part of the premises shall be let separately from the whole and no part of the premises shall be used otherwise than for the purposes of aprivate dwelling
- (2) No sign or advertisement shall be displayed on the premises so as to be visible from outside the premises except that a nameplate not exceeding 4 square inches in size may be displayed at an entrance
- (3) No alteration shall be made to the external appearance of the buildings on the premises (including the colouring scheme) except with the prior written consent of the Society
- (4) No alteration shall be made to the garden walls fences or delineation of boundaries on the premises except with the prior written consent of the Society
- (5) No building or other structure shall be erected in the williage of the premises except with the prior written consent of the enciety
  - (6) No exterior aerial shall be erected on the premises
- (7) No car caravan or similar vehicle shall be parked in the swillings of the premises otherwise than in a garage or (in the size of a private car not standing higher at any point than 5 feet
  - 6 inches above the ground and not bearing any sign or advertisement) on a car parking space
  - (8) Nothing shall be done or omitted to be done on the premises that may interfere with the amenity of other property owners or occupiers on the estate
